## **1. ANNOUNCEMENT**

The Tamworth Motorcycle Club hereafter called the Promoter will conduct the 2011 Australian Senior Long Track Championship for senior riders with senior and junior support events at Tamworth Showground on Saturday 5th February 2011.

## **2. JURISDICTION**

2.1 The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by MA which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number MA 0920 and is open to current Motorcycling Australia Senior National and Junior National license holders with log books.

2.2 The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport 2011, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by MA. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions.

## **3. EVENT OFFICIALS**

## **4. ENTRIES**

4.1 Entries are now open and close last mail Friday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2011. Late entries will not be accepted.

4.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Tamworth Motorcycle Club Inc if such retention is approved by MA

4.3 Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

4.4 Entry fees will only be refunded if a rider informs the Tamworth Motorcycle Club Inc in writing, 7 days before the event. A medical certificate is required if a rider withdraws less than 7 days before the event.

## **5. ENTRY FEE**

5.1 Entry Fee of \$100 per Solo & Quads riders & \$110 for Sidecars and \$25 for any additional senior class (MA Rider Levy included in this fee plus ambulance levy). Junior support class entry will be \$80 per solo rider and \$15 for any additional junior class. Senior support will be \$90 and \$15 for any additional support class.

## **6. ENTRY PASSES**

Solo & Quads will be 2 Passes  
Sidecar will be 3 passes

## **7. INSURANCE**

7.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

7.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

It is strongly recommended that competitors give consideration to taking out weekly benefits insurance.

## **8. MEDICAL SERVICES**

NSW AMBULANCE will be in attendance from 12noon until 30 minutes after the completion of racing.

## 9. SCRUTINEERING

9.1 Scrutineering will begin at 10am on Saturday 5th February 2010

9.2 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in practice, qualifying or racing. An MA decal will be placed on the front number plate to indicate that it has been successfully examined. Changing of machines will be prohibited after the completion of round 1.

9.3 Current competition licenses, log books and full riding gear must be presented at scrutineering. **Please note amendments to the 2011 MOMs in respect to protective clothing.** Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting. Machines which suffer accident damage in practice or race sessions must be re-examined before participating again.

9.4 In addition to supervising the pulling down and checking of machines after official protests have been received by the Clerk of Course in accordance with the GCRs, the Steward can order that any machine be measured and if this occurs the Scrutineer will supervise a team member to pull down any machine that has taken part in the event. Failure to comply with this rule will result in automatic exclusion from the event results.

9.5 Machines will not be sealed for later checking after the event. All machines that are to be pulled down and scrutineered will take place at the circuit before the machine is released by the Scrutineer. A member of the rider's team must be available at all times to carry out the strip down under the control of the Scrutineer. Failure to comply with this rule will result in automatic exclusion from the events results.

## 11. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

11.1 To constitute a class for the purpose of gaining Championship status, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be 10 or more starters for solo classes, which actually participate in practice, qualifying or races. Sidecars shall be 6 or more starters which actually participate in practice, qualifying or races.

11.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prize money, will be at the discretion of the Tamworth Motorcycle Club Inc, subject to MA approval.

## 12. RACE FORMAT

**For 12 or less Senior Solo competitor classes shall be conducted as straight through rounds over 3 rounds accumulative scored, with points allocated in each leg as per GCRS rule.**

**12.14 To determine placing. All events will be 3laps.**

**For more than 12 Senior Solo Competitors there shall be 3 rounds of qualifying heats, a 1 race repercharge and a 1 race final. All heats will be 3 laps Final will be 4 laps.**

**The right to compete in the final will be filled by 8 competitors accumulating the highest number of points During the course of heats and the first 4 placing of the repercharge. The finishing order of each competitor in The final will determine over all placings. Point scoring as per GCRS 12.14.**

**Support Classes will be run over 3 rounds with 3 laps in each round.**

#### **14. EVENT SCHEDULE**

**Gates Open at 10am**  
**Scrutineering 10am**  
**Rider Briefing 12 noon**  
**Practice after rider briefing**  
**Racing straight after practice**

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 5<sup>th</sup> February 2011 will be 10am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

#### **16. GST**

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prize money over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

#### **17. PRESENTATIONS**

Presentation of all awards will be made on the track immediately after each event.  
Championship winners will be presented with MA medallions.

#### **18. MACHINES AND RIDERS**

18.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Australian Long Track competition.

18.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

18.3 Scrutineered machines must remain in the pit area at all times between races and can only be removed with the permission of the COC. Failure to comply will result in exclusion from the meeting.

18.4 All machines must remain impounded in the selected area at the conclusion of the meeting for a period of 30mins to allow for eligibility protest to occur.  
During this time, no machine in the classes impounded shall be removed from the selected area.  
To do so will incur immediate exclusion from the result of that class.

#### **19 MEASURING**

Measuring of the top 4 place getters from any class may occur at this meeting

#### **20 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION**

A protective matting or catch tray must be placed underneath the engine / gearbox and fuel tank of any solo or Sidecar while parked in the pit, paddock or work area.

#### **21. RIDING NUMBERS**

Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding number or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Tamworth Motorcycle Club Inc discretion.

All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCRs and must not contain any decals or advertising other than the required MA decal.

#### **22. GRID POSITIONS**

Grid positions for all heats and rounds will be per drawn and printed in the program.  
Rider's choice for grid position in the final will apply. Top point scorer has 1<sup>st</sup> choice and so on as per point score result.

## 23. RIDERS' BRIEFING

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which **ALL competitors MUST attend.**

All parents and Guardians for riders U/18 years MUST also attend. Details will be included in final instructions.

## 24. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

780mts of Granite Sand.

All riders will be given the opportunity to inspect the circuit on foot. If a rider has a safety issue with the track, this should be taken up with the Clerk of Course.

## 25. FACILITIES

Canteen, Showers, Toilets are available.

## 26. NOISE TESTING & COMPLIANCE

Noise testing may take place at any time at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer or the Clerk of Course. Refer to GCR 12.10 for details. Must not exceed 98db as per MOMS rule 12.10.1.1

## 27. TYRES

**Knobby tyres are not permitted at all except for the 85cc support classes.**

## 28. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

28.1 All competitors and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy, as carried out by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority. Refer to GCR 11 for details.

28.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at MA discretion until the results of the tests are known.

## 29. ALCOHOL TESTING PROCEDURE

All competitors and officials are advised that random breath-testing may take place during the competition.

## 30. CODE OF CONDUCT

**All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of MA's Code of Conduct contained within MA's Member Protection Regulations, found at [www.ma.org.au](http://www.ma.org.au) or Appendix 3 of the GCR, which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This Code of Conduct applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.**

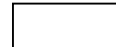

## CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 2011 AUSTRALIAN SENIOR LONG TRACK CHAMPIONSHIPS

**WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS, PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.**

1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below): [Insert Name]

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

### 2. DEFINITIONS

- a) "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- b) "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- c) "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- d) "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
- e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

### 3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- a) motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
  - i) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
  - ii) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
  - iii) that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
  - iv) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
  - v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
  - vi) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
  - vii) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
  - viii) that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
- b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- c) to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- d) have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

### 4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:

- rendered with due care and skill;
- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

**NOTE:** The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations

2004.  
For the purposes of the clause 3, "the Supplier" shall mean and include the Indemnitees.

### 5. INDEMNITY AND RELEASE GIVEN TO ORGANISERS

IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of me as a participant in the Meeting:

- a) I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them in the following manner:
  - i) that I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
  - ii) that I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;
  - iii) that I indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnitees, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions, costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.
- b) I AGREE TO RELEASE to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them from all liability to me for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, psychological trauma, death, property damage or infringement of third party rights or otherwise) that arises as a result of any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by me or which is in any way connected with my presence at or involvement in the Event.
- 6. The release and indemnity provided by me in this declaration is in addition to, and will not in any way limit the application of, the conditions of sale attaching to tickets, conditions of entry, conditions of credentials or any other applicable terms or conditions in respect of the Event.
- 7. A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

### 8. MEDICAL

I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Meeting. I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept the Indemnitees will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.

- 9. I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

### 10. PRIVACY

I hereby consent to the collection of my personal information by the Tamworth MCC, MA and the SCB in connection with my involvement at the Event and the use and disclosure of my personal information by Tamworth MCC, and MA to other agencies and officials associated with the Event for the purposes of conducting and managing the Event. I understand that I may gain access to my personal information held by Tamworth MCC by contacting Tamworth MCC at PO Box 3050 West Tamworth NSW 2340 or MA at 147 Montague St, South Melbourne, Victoria, 3205. I understand that if I do not provide the personal information requested above that I may not be permitted to participate in the Event.

### 11. PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION

I hereby agree with MA and the SCB that in consideration for my participation in the Event that MA and the SCB may receive, collect, store and use personal health information about me in the manner set out below:

- a) I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
  - i) If I am injured, become ill or die at or following the Event the party listed at Item 8 in Schedule 1 in addition to any hospital at which I am treated (together "my Carers") will have health related information about me in their possession, power and control relating to me which is subject to obligations imposed by the Privacy Act ("my Information") and the Privacy Act is intended to protect my personal information;
  - ii) MA and my SCB wish to collect my Information for purposes that include their risk management programs, evaluating and improving the safety of MA and SCB events and of the Meeting organisers and facility providers

of MA / SCB permitted events, and generally to reduce the risks to persons engaged in motorcycle sport and

- iii) It is reasonable for MA and my SCB to collect, store, use and disclose my Information in accordance with clause 11(a)(i) above and in the manner set out in clause 11(b).
- b) IN CONSIDERATION of my acceptance as an entrant in the Meeting I consent and agree that MA and my SCB:
  - i) may collect and store any of my Information, including obtain my Information from third parties including my Carers;
  - ii) may use any information collected in accordance with this clause for any purpose consistent with creating safer competition in motorcycle sport and events held by or in conjunction with MA, my SCB, or with an MA or SCB permit;
