

Addendum to the Minutes of the CMX/CDT Commission

Meeting of 9th May 2012 as attached

Per CMX 324

It has come to the attention to the Commission that there are conflicts within the GCR's in relation to the new rules as adopted in 2011 and those in section 12 of the GCR's. It is the purpose of this document to address the issues specific to machine specific requirements.

Amend 12.8.3

To include "other than CMX / CDT"

Rationale

Exhaust systems are dealt with in the machine specifications of section 18. The application of this rule in 12 is not compatible with CMX/CDT

Amend 12.8.5

To include "other than CMX / CDT"

Rationale

Foot rests are dealt with in the machine specifications of section 18. The application of this rule in 12 is not compatible with CMX/CDT. CMX foot pegs do touch the ground and the inclusion of springs is not practicable on most machines.

Amend 12.8.8.6

To include "other than CMX / CDT"

Rationale

The application of this rule has caused confusion to many competitors' and is not particle to enforce on machines where it will be difficult to incorporate this requirement.

There was no consultation with this commission when including this rule.

There has been no issues arise that may have made it a requirement.

Amend 12.8.11

To include CMX / CDT

Rationale

The application of these requirements directly conflicts with the machine specific requirements outlined in section 18 of the GCR's.

The Commission requests these alterations to the 2013 GCR's as a interim measure before further discussion next year. It also recommends that there is a need to review these matters and others of rule conflict to improve the GCR's generally and stands ready to assist as required.
